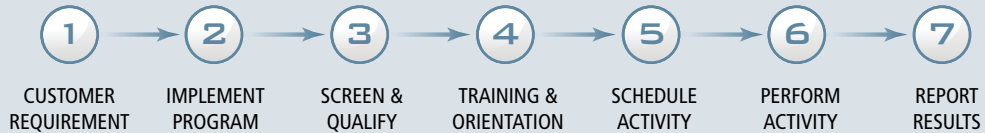

TASK TYPES	TROUBLESHOOTING	An activity, using various techniques, to determine the root cause of problems so effective corrective action can be implemented.
	ERROR PROOFING	The implementation of functional and human factor improvements to prevent recurrence of a problem.
	QUALITY ENGINEERING	A discipline to minimize process variations and eliminate waste using engineering methods such as Six Sigma, Lean Manufacturing, and Statistical Process Control.
	CORRECTIVE ACTION MANAGEMENT	The management, follow-up, validation, closure, and technical oversight of supplier corrective actions taken in response to a discrepancy or improvement opportunity.
	SUPPLIER SURVEILLANCE	An examination of supplier activities to confirm initial or ongoing compliance to customer performance, quality, or schedule requirements.
	MANAGEMENT & PRODUCTION CONTROL	The oversight and management of supplier activities to ensure customer quality and schedule requirements are achieved.
